

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR

As a TruPartner Credit Union member, you are eligible for two scholarship opportunities!

This year, TruPartner Credit Union is awarding a \$1,000 scholarship for post-high school studies in the 2021-2022 school year. In addition, the Credit Union Outreach Alliance is awarding at least eight \$1,000 scholarships for the same purpose.

To qualify, you must be at least a senior in a local high school and plan to enroll in post-high school studies, including vocational, professional and academic studies, which are not limited to colleges and universities. Applicants may also be anyone who is obtaining an Associates or Bachelor Degree. You yourself must be a primary member of TruPartner Credit Union to be eligible.

By submitting this application, you will be considered for scholarships by both, TruPartner Credit Union and the Cincinnati Area Credit Union Outreach Alliance.
